About MSM

Mar Severios Memorial(MSM) ITI, Piravom, is owned by the diocese of Muvattupuzha of the Malankara Syrian Catholic Church. It was established under the diocese of Thiruvalla in 1980 by Rev.Fr.Chako Elavumparambil, a native of Piravom . He had a dream of transforming young lives of this place and he cherished it in the establishment of this ITI with the blessing and support of the bishop of Thiruvalla, His Excellency Most Rev. Issac Mar Yoohanon, another native of Piravom. When the diocese of Thiruvalla was bifurcated and the new diocese of Muvattupuzha was formed in 2003, the ownership of the ITI has been transferred to the diocese of Muvattupuzha. At present, it is managed by Mar Severios Memorial Educational and Charitable Trust with the bishop of Muvattupuzha as the patron.



The ITI is situated near govt. hospital, Piravom in Ernakulam district in the state of kerala, India. It has a campus spread over four acres and has a calm and pleasant atomosphere. The ITI, started with two trades, Draughtsman(civil) and Fitter, has grown now to the status of an ISO certified institution offering training in six NCVT approved trades.

They are Draughtsman (civil), Electrician, Electronics Mechanic, Fitter, Mechanic (Motor Vechicle) and Plumber. The ITI is unique with a blend of Industry Experienced faculty, success oriented students and updated infrastructure. More over, we are blessed with conglomerates of supportive firms and industries which provide both technical facilities and employment opportunities.

During the past 42 years more than 8000 students have been trained in this institution and almost all of them got placement in different companies and establishments in and abroad. Many others have become entrepreneurs.

The Campus

The ITI is located near Govt. Hospital in piravom town in Ernakulam District and is easily accessible by public transport. It is spread out over three acres of land and has a calm and pleasant atmosphere

Timing

Curriculum and Syllabus

The courses are conducted as per the NCVT curriculum and syllabus. The syllabus includes theory, practical, calculation and engineering drawing

Examinations and Progress Report

Apart from the NCVT examination, monthly tests and quarterly examinations are conducted and remedial classes are given to the weak students. After each quarterly examination, parents' meetings are convened and Progress report of the trainees are given to the parents.

Parent - Teachers Meeting

To discuss the progress of the trainees, parent - teachers meetings are conducted twice in an academic year.

Draughtsman (Civil)

During the two year duration, the candidates are trained on subjects such as professional skill, professional knowledge and employability skills related to job role. They are taught to prepare drawings of buildings, stores, steel structures, roof tresses etc. and also to prepare their estimate. Besides, they are made aware of the tools and equipments used in the construction field and of the safety measures to be followed there. Those who complete the course and secure certificate have tremendous job opportunities both in public and private sectors.





Electrician

In the two year Electrician Trade, the trainees are trained on professional skills and knowledge ,engineering drawing ,workshop calculation & science and employability skills related to job role. The students are taught to install, maintain and repair electrical machinery equipments and fittings in factories, business and residential premises, to fit and assemble motors, generators, switch gears, fans etc. and all other electrical works.

Electricians are in high demand in all walks of life in India as well as abroad. They have diverse job opportunities both in govt. and private sectors. Self-employment is another scope of this course.






Electronics Mechanic

In the context of Electronics industry and the number of electronic gadgets growing to new horizons, this course has great relevance. In this course, the trainees are taught the PCB testing, servicing and repairing of all kinds of electronic equipments. Besides, they are taught the installation of solar panel, optical fibre cables, stabilizer, inverter etc. and the assembling and servicing of computer, UPS, mobile phone, T V etc. The Electronics Technicians are in high demind in technical institutes, industrial establishments and business concerns.





Fitter

The trainees in this course are trained on professional skills, professional knowledge, engineering drawing, workshop science and calculation and employability skills related to job role. In addition to this, they are imparted training on allied trades viz, sheet metal, welding etc. which leads to multi-skilling. They are also introduced to power tool operation, different complex assembling and fitting, different types of fabrication works, pipe works etc. Those who secure NCVT certificate in this trade have lot of job opportunities in various Govt. departments, industrial sector and private companies.









Mechanic (Motor Vechicle)

In this course ,the students are imparted training in the overhauling functions, repairs , servicing and maintenance of all types of motor vehicles. They also learn to perform the overhauling of light and heavy vehicle transmission units including gear box, clutch assembly, axle assembly etc. For the effective and precisive transaction of these skills, we have an amazing workshop with most modern tools, equipments and machines. Besides, the cut out section of various models of engines help the students understand the inside of the engines and their working processes with precision. Students who pass out this trade will get employment in various Govt. departments like KSRTC, Water Transport , Agriculture, Police, Health etc.





Plumber

During the one year duration, the candidates learn the basic pipe works viz cutting of pipes, threading, joining, fitting, fixing and laying of pipeline. They are also trained in installation and maintenance of electric pumps. Plumbers are one of the most sought after technicians everywhere. They are in great demand in the construction field and in the service segment. They have also good scope to become self-entrepreneurs.





Admission Process

Admission starts normally in the month of May and closes in September. However, the new academic year commences in August. We admit male and female candidates irrespective of Caste, Creed, Colour etc. Those who seek admission in this ITI should submit an application in the prescribed form. First Come, First Serve is our admission policy. Once the application is received, the candidates will be taken to the various labs and workshops to familiarise them with the trades which would help them to decide on the trade they would like to join. Then, they have to attend an interview and a counselling session in which the trade choice of the candidate is finalised and admission is granted. The admitted candidates will be intimated the opening of class personally.

General instructions to trainees

Discipline

MSM ITI gives equal importance to both academic activities and discipline. Therefore, all the trainees are expected to obey the rules and regulations of the ITI and maintain good discipline.

Leave

Trainees who were absent in class must submit proper leave letter signed by their parents/Guardian. Incase of absence due to illness for more than a week, medical certificate should be produced to get attendance.

Attendance

The trainees should have 80% of attendance to appear for NCVT examination. So, all the trainees must attend the classes regularly and punctually.

Uniform and ID Card

The trainees must wear the prescribed uniform and identity card on the campus on all days.

Fees

All the fees are to be paid in time. Fees, once remitted, shall not be paid back if a trainee terminates his study due to own reason or he is dismissed for any grave offence. No trainee will be allowed to appear for the NCVT examination unless all the fees are cleared.

Relationship with Others

The trainees are expected to maintain a good code of conduct and a healthy relationship with teachers and fellow trainees. They must obey and respect the teachers and behave properly to the other staffs of the institution.
